A new subsidiary of Japan's Sanyo, Sanyo Solar of Oregon, is building an \$80m plant for the production of silicon ingots and wafers, its second in the US, in the Salem Renewable Energy & Technology Park in Salem, Orgeon, US. Start-up is scheduled for October 2009 with full operation from April 2010. The 70MW production capacity will bring Sanyo's total US ingot and wafer production to around 100MW, and forms part of its planning to establish a global production capacity of at least 600MW by 2010.
