**TOK America**, a subsidiary of Japan based Tokyo Ohka Kogyo, was one of the first Japanese companies to begin operations in Hillsboro in 1993.

TOK produces ultra high purity photoresist and auxiliary chemicals used in the fabrication of integrated circuits for customers in the US and Europe. Applications for their products are used in cell phones, flat screen televisions, personal computers, vehicles, and portable music players. The Hillsboro plant serves as their US headquarters and manufacturing facility, employing 78.

Located in Hillsboro's north industrial area and within the **Hillsboro Enterprise Zone (E-zone)**, TOK was awarded an enterprise zone exemption for their "Clean Solutions Building" representing their third expansion in May 2009. The project was a 40,000 sf production, warehouse, and laboratory facility, representing a \$13 million investment.
