The building was originally built for Lippert Components, Inc. which produced chassis for Fleetwood and Keystone. The building and equipment utilized an enterprise zone property tax exemption for 3 years.

Last year the property/facility was sold to Kinro, it now produces cabinets and window frames for Keystone and other RV manufacturing companies. Drew Industries, which now owns Kinro and Lippert, utilized enterprise property taxes abatement and Oregon State SRF (forgivable loan) for the Kinro update, and later utilized the BOOST program for moving Lippert back to Pendleton from McMinnville.

Kinro created 80 jobs, and Lippert moved 12 of the 23 jobs back from McMinnville.
