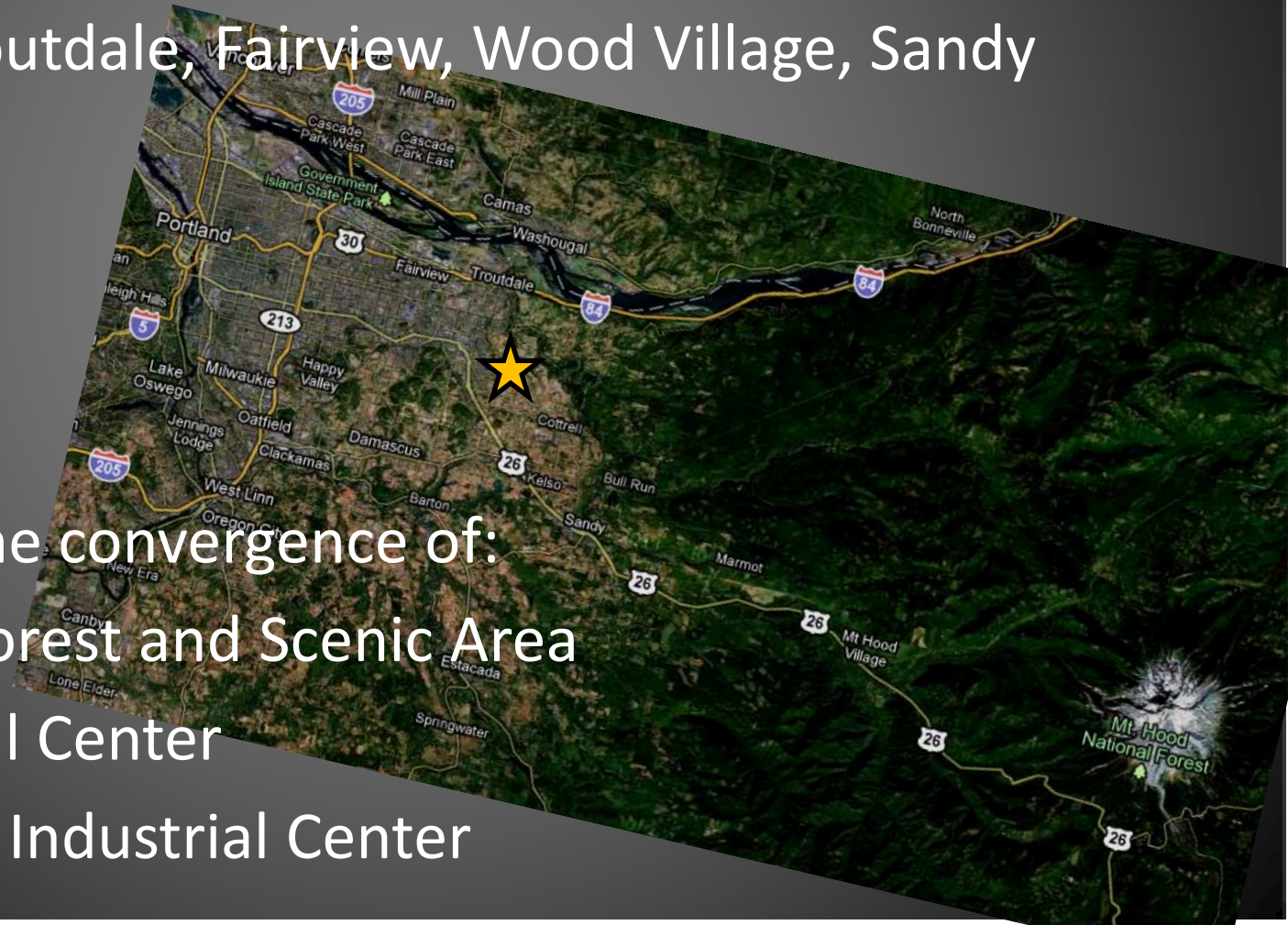

Gresham, Troutdale, Fairview, Wood Village, Sandy



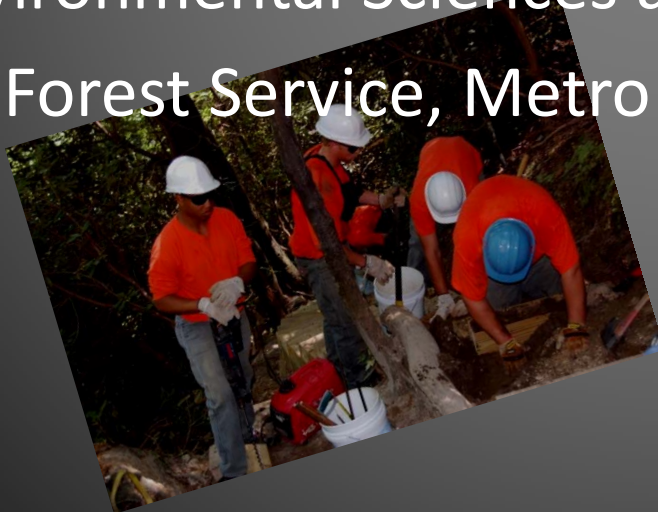
